Call to Order

The meeting came to order at 7:00 pm.

Business

1. Discussion of postponing December Community Engagement meeting due to plumbing issue at the Ohiopyle Stewart Community Center. A rescheduled date for after the holidays is being considered.
2. Whit commented that the last monthly council meeting was very positive. He appreciated the specific agenda and resolutions acted upon by the borough council.
3. Signage update: Conrad reported the street signage project is ongoing. A new quote is quote from A1 Signage for the November 20, 2025 Ohiopyle Borough Council meeting.
4. A mercantile tax is in the works but needs involvement of a solicitor. It has been proposed that the tax be a percentage instead of milage.
5. The future of the steering committee membership was discussed. All members presented stated their desire to remain on the committee. Conrad will reach out to Bruce King to see what is level of interest is at this point. Discussion of additional members was proposed.
6. Continued discussion of concerns related need for zoning enforcement within the borough and the need for ordinance creation regarding parking for short term rentals and use of campers within the borough.
7. Conrad mentioned that a the council has mailed out a letter to all short term rentals regarding an annual \$300 fee to be paid to the borough.
8. Discussion of need for Ohiopyle Borough website to be updated with an advertisement for a new borough solicitor. Discussion of reaching out to other boroughs to find out who they are using as their solicitor.
9. Options for trash pickup and collection briefly discussed with more research to be done on options available to Ohiopyle. Feedback needed from local community members to discuss various options.

10. McMillan Engineering will be presenting a proposal at the next monthly council meeting. They are being considered as a possible replacement for K2 Engineering.
11. The next Steering Committee virtual meeting is scheduled for December 10, 2025 at 7:00pm.
